ANIMAL CENTRE VOLUNTEER

Volunteering at our Animal Centre is a big commitment but one you will find extremely rewarding. We require assistance during weekdays and on weekends. You will help with a variety of tasks, including;

- Cleaning – animal cages, centre buildings etc.
- Feeding animals.
- Grooming and caring for animals.
- Laundry duties.
- Welcoming visitors to our Centre.
- Any other support services as required.

If you are keen to assist, there are some conditions you must consider before sending in your application form;

- Centre volunteers must be 17 years or over.
- You must attend an Induction evening prior to starting work.
- You must commit to a roster, working at least twice a month for six months.
- Prior animal care and/or volunteer experience is an advantage but not essential.

If you are interested in becoming an Animal Centre volunteer, visit our website to view our current vacancies and register for our next volunteer induction. Interviews, referee and criminal checks may be undertaken prior to acceptance. Volunteer positions are limited and we will only accept those who best fit our criteria.

DOG SQUAD VOLUNTEER

Dog squad volunteers take our orphan dogs on regular walks and offer some much needed human interaction/play time. Volunteers teach our dogs to walk politely on a lead and socialise with them, helping them learn how to play and behave appropriately with humans. Dogs with good basic manners are much easier to adopt into loving new homes. Full training and equipment is provided.

To join our dog squad some conditions apply, including;

- Dog squad volunteers must be 18 years or over.
- You must attend an Induction evening prior to starting work.
- You must be able to commit to a roster.
- Previous dog ownership/responsibility, and knowledge of dog behaviour/training techniques, will be an advantage.

EVENT AND ADMINISTRATION VOLUNTEER
